The top honorees were Flashpoint Building Systems and Nosh Foods, who secured victories in the main pitch and Trailmix competitions, respectively. Additionally, Revnest was granted \$100,000 in equity funding from Connetic Ventures.

Main pitch winners:

- Pat Churchman and Nick Stoppello, co-founders of Flashpoint Building Systems
 (https://www.flashpointbuildingsystems.com/), received \$50,000 for their patented
 technology that streamlines floor-plan creation for building subfloor systems,
 eliminating manual errors and saving time.
- John Rubocki, co-founder of SeekingSimple (https://www.seekingsimple.com/), was awarded \$5,000 as the runner-up. SeekingSimple uses consumer behavior data, food gredient information, grocery store integration and digital tools to address aminent food-related diseases.
- Ehsan Soltan, founder of Soiltech Wireless (https://www.soiltechwireless.com/home), received \$5,000 as the winner of In Time Tec's Abundance Award, recognizing community-focused pitch finalists. Soiltech Wireless developed a soil sensor that tracks data throughout the agricultural growth cycle.
